- Skipper must be a member of one of the Five T'aaq-wiihak Nations and registered with Ha'oom fisheries
- Skipper is responsible for completing all required logbooks/reporting to keep license in good standing, including addressing any overages before the season ends.

If you are interested in submitting a bid, please complete the following form and deliver the completed forms to this address in person, or by email or mail.

Bids received after the bid closing date and time listed above will not be accepted.

All bids received by the aforementioned deadline shall be reviewed by HFS Board of Directors. The successful Fisher will be selected based on evaluation of the appended License/Quota Decision Guide.
