Conditions of Access:

- An electronic monitoring (EM) system is a requirement in the Five Nations' right-based sale fishery for crab.
- License holders must provide Ha'oom with active hauling records during the determined license term.

Please note: license holders will have traps reallocated to other interested participants if not used within a designated period.

If you are interested in applying, please complete the following forms (two pages) and deliver the completed forms to our office in person or send in by email or mail. **Applications will continue to be received until trap access is fully allocated.** All applications received shall be reviewed by HFS Board of Directors. The successful fishers will be selected based on evaluation of the appended License/Quota Decision Guide.
